"Jesus Loves the Little Children..."

This God-ordained mission trip to Ethiopia began taking root in my life four years ago when I dreamed about orphaned children in far-away places. Then, two years ago, God burned Africa into my heart, then Ethiopia.

After watching two documentaries on orphaned children in Mozambique and Ethiopia, I knew God was calling me to not only do missions in Ethiopia but to someday adopt an Ethiopian orphan. I began to pray fervently that God would guide my steps, and He answered by opening many doors so I could attend a short-term mission trip to Ethiopia led by "All God's Children International."

My heart was broken for God's children when I arrived at Lola Children's home in Mekele, Ethiopia, an orphanage for children who are HIV affected and their siblings. Prayers were answered daily as we ministered to women and loved on the orphans at Lola. The needs continue to be great, as there are 5.5 million orphans and approximately 1,600 orphanages in Ethiopia alone. Children who are affected by HIV are the last to be fed. clothed. and housed.


