
Christmas Event

Embracing the New Year!

In many churches, the anticipation of a new year is celebrated in a latenight service on December 31 called "Watch Night." This service allows Christians to praise God for the past year and pray for the year ahead. Most of these services have some combination of prayers, testimonies, singing, sermons, and/or other special celebrations.

Of special historical significance to some African-Americans is that many slaves were said to have gathered in churches on New Year's eve in 1862 awaiting news of the enactment of the Emancipation Proclamation by President Abraham Lincoln on January 1, 1863.

WATCH NIGHT SERVICE

Monday, December 31, 2012


